



# COASTSIDE CAMPS

## FALL 2020

This flyer is to inform families of day or afternoon camp activities that have openings in support of Cabrillo Unified School District's (CUSD's) Modified School Operations in fall 2020 due to COVID-19. Camps are not licensed childcare providers, but are designed to be educational enrichment opportunities to support CUSD students and families. These camp providers are independent of CUSD and have not been endorsed or vetted by CUSD.

**All camps have limited scholarships based on Free and Reduced Lunch eligibility within CUSD; contact camp directly for details.**

Camp providers will practice the four pillars and perform health screenings of campers at drop-off each day. Coronavirus is not always symptomatic, so there is still risk of exposure despite health screenings and alignment with the four pillars of safety. As with all camps, signed liability waivers will be mandatory for all campers. Camp schedules are subject to change or be cancelled in response to changes in community health needs or directives.

Campers are expected to wear masks (or gaiters) at camp regardless of age. Many camps listed are open to hosting a limited number of teens to support camp operations; contact camp operator to discuss.
