Updating our fields

Thanks to our partnership with the Coastsides Boys & Girls club the soccer fields at Cunha Intermediate School and the Baseball field at HMBHS will be undergoing a much needed renovation this summer!

Timeline

This project will begin on June 9th. It will impact not only the fields in both locations, but parking in the Cunha lot. As safety is our #1 priority, extra planning has been done to make sure any students that are on the Cunha or HMBHS campuses during the summer cannot access the construction areas.

Environmentally Conscious

Replacing field turf can create substantial waste, with even recycling having limitations for such large volumes of material. To address this environmental concern, all of the old field turf will be repurposed to minimize waste creation. Additionally, many older turf products contain Polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS), synthetic chemicals that persist in the environment. Rest assured, our project uses only materials that have been rigorously tested and confirmed to be PFAS-free, prioritizing both environmental responsibility and the health of our community.
